Accepted materials include the following:



**Aluminum & Tin Beverage and Food Containers:**

Please rinse out soda, vegetable, & fruit cans. No paint cans, aerosol cans or other potentially harmful or hazardous cans.



**Paper:**

newspapers, magazines, catalogs, office paper, junk mail, shredded paper



**Corrugated Cardboard:**

pre-flatten boxes

**Fiberboard:**

beverage, cereal, cake mix, pasta, cracker/gift boxes, etc.



**Plastics:** #1 and #2 ONLY, rinsed, and lids removed

Please check # inside the recycle symbol on bottom of plastic container



Transparent or clear including most water bottles, beverages, food items (peanut butter & fruit containers, salad dressing bottles), shampoo & mouthwash bottles, and more



Typically include milk jugs, detergent/bleach/fabric softener bottles, plastic bottles of lawn/garden products, and more

The following items can be recycled by drop-off only at: Bell County Recycling Center

- Batteries:** automobile, lawn mower, motorcycle, ATV
- e-scrap (Computers & Accessories):** CPUs, desktop computers, monitors, eReader Devices, laptop, netbook or tablets, flat-screen televisions, printers & fax machines, Smartphones or PDAs, cellphones or pagers, landline telephone components, copy or multi-function machines, routers, etc. The *only exception* is not flat-screen Televisions which are currently not being accepted.
- White Goods:** by appointment only, please contact the Bell County Solid Waste Coordinator at 606.337.7035. (stoves, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dishwashers, washers/dryers, microwaves, and other appliance or heavy metal items)
